



Privacy Policy

C2 RIBS are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998, the data controller is C2 RIBS. The GDPR rules were introduced in 2018 and our policies under this are available on request.

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site <http://c2ribs.co.uk/> (**our site**) This includes information provided when you complete our online accounts form and enquiry form.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our site and of the fulfilment of your orders.
- Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data, whether this is required for our own billing purposes or otherwise and the resources that you access.
- Please note: No information is recorded or stored on our web sever at any point while filling in forms or moving around the site.

IP addresses and cookies

We may collect information where available your variable IP address, operating system and browser type. This does not identify any individual.

Cookies contain information that are transferred to your computer's hard drive and only last for 30 days.

C2 RIBS use the following cookies

Google Analytics (__utmz, __utmc, __utmb, __utma)

These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site for you. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. We also use Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting data from Google's Interest-based advertising or 3rd-party audience data (such as age, gender and interests) with Google Analytics. This information is in an anonymous form and will never be passed on to a third party

Google Maps (APISID, HSID, NID, PREF, SAPISID, SID,SSID)

These cookies are used by Google to store user preferences and information when viewing pages with Google maps on them. Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. Storing your personal data

We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy. No information is kept on the server from any forms submitted.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Uses made of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- To ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.

- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so.
- To notify you about changes to our service.

We may also use your data, or permit selected third parties to use your data, to provide you with information about goods and services which may be of interest to you and we or they may contact you about these by post, telephone, or email.

If you are an existing customer, we will only contact you by electronic means (e-mail or SMS) with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale to you.

If you are a new customer, and where we permit selected third parties to use your data, we (or they) will contact you by electronic means only if you have consented to this.

If you do not want us to use your data in this way, or to pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data the enquiry form.

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If C2 RIBS or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms and conditions and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of C2RIBS, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Your rights

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data. You can also exercise the right at any time by contacting us at C2RIBS.
